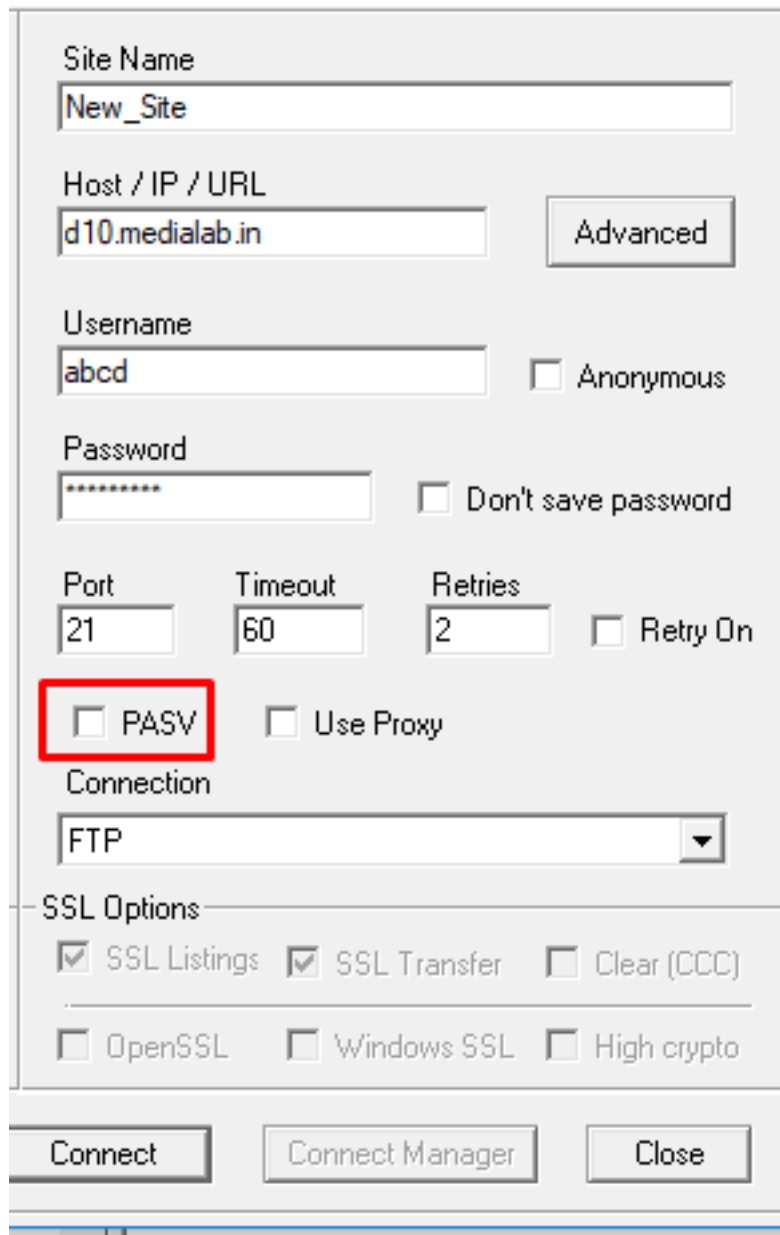


Connecting to FTP Service on S Series Servers

We recommend using CoreFTP which can be downloaded for free from <http://www.coreftp.com/download.html>

Use the following settings. **Take Special care to UNCHECK PASV**
